Kinn island: Highly recommended!

200 m from quayside by boat
Duration: 3.5 hrs

2 km walk on Kinn Island.
Far out in the sea lies the beautiful and green Kinn Island. The Island is a wonderful place for great nature and cultural experiences. Kinn is well known for its medieval church and the characteristic mountain cleft Kinnaklova. We offer a guided experience in the legendary Kinn church, which was built in a Romanesque style, and is one of the oldest in Norway. We guarantee an impressive and impressive experience with narration and music. Concerts in the church for up to 120 people can be arranged on request.

The 360 Summit: Florø and surroundings

Coastal Contrasts: A great blend selection from Sunnfjord

We go to the village of Naustdal, famous for its salmon river, and visit the Black Friday Museum, returning along the beautiful Førdefjord. We stop at one of Norway's largest and most interesting rock carving sites, Ausevika. More than 300 figures have been found here.



The Scenic Route: Florø-Bremanger

This tour includes highlights such as the village of Kalvåg and the wonderful beach Grotlesanden. A scenic roundtrip packed with historical highlights.

Venice of the North: Bulandet and Værlandet

300 m from quayside by boat

Værlandet and Bulandet are the westernmost inhabited island communities in Norway. They have a unique landscape with special crags combined with marshland and lakes. Bulandet has 365 islands and is referred to as "Venice of the north".
