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## The "Silver Ring" Walk and suggestions for activities in the village centre

The green route is the so called „Silver Ring” - a 1.5 to 2 hours walk passing by the most important cultural monuments of Vik:

Vikøyri (1) is the historical Shore Dweller Site, protected by law.

Borgstova (2) from 1864 is one of two houses which are still standing from the old officer's farm at Sjøtun in Vik.

Hopperstad Stave Church (3) is one of the oldest stavechurches in Norway. It was built around 1130.

Moahaugane (4) is the name of a field with several distinctive burial mounds from 200–400 AD.

Hove Stone Church (5) is the oldest stone building in the Sognefjord region and probably one of the oldest in the country. It was built at the end of the 12th century.
