**Bus excursions - all excursions can be combined.**

**Hellesylt - Geiranger excursion**  
Start from Geiranger or Hellesylt - Enjoy a unique picture of magnificent fjords, snowcapped mountains, ice-blue lakes, plunging waterfalls and glaciers. The excursion includes either the Old Strynefjell road, Briksdal glacier, Loen lake, Kjennedal glacier, Loen Skylift, Skywalk Geiranger, Dalsnibba or Flydalsjuvet Viewpoint.

**Mount Stranda panorama.**  
A scenic bus ride from Hellesylt to Mount Stranda. Take a gondola lift up to 1066 masl to the most magnificent panorama view of the fjord landscape.

**Skywalk Geiranger Dalsnibba and Grotli.**  
A round trip to Skywalk Geiranger Dalsnibba, Stryn Mountains and Grotli. See the beautiful and varied scenery of the glaciers and mountains.

**Herdal Mountain Farm**  
A traditional summer farm with over 450 goats and other animals. Sample milk product from the farm. Have a stop at the beautiful scenic Eagle bend viewpoint.

**Ljøen Mountain farm**  
Start from Hellesylt cruise pier - experience an authentic sheepdog training by local trainers on the mountain farms while enjoying the magnificent view of the Geirangerfjord.

**Norangsdaalen Valley and Ljøen Viewpoint - A feeling of National Romance**  
A scenic ride through the wild and rugged Norang Valley, with a stop at Ljøen viewpoint. Get the feeling of being in a painting from the national romantic period 100 years ago.

**Lake Hornindalsvatn**  
A trip through towering mountains, farmland and picturesque scenery leads to Lake Hornindal, the deepest lake in Europe.

**Nordfjord Panorama and the Norwegian Fjord Horse Centre**  
A trip along the beautiful Nordfjord. Passing Europe's deepest lake "Lake Hornindal." At Nordfjordeid Horse Centre you will be presented to the stallions and catch a ride on a carriage.

**Geiranger excursions**  
**Geiranger Skywalk Dalsnibba**  
Europe's highest fjord view by road - 1500 masl. The view is spectacular and varied. The weather changes quickly and you can experience all four seasons in one day.

**Flydalsjuvet viewpoint**  
Possibly the most popular postcard motif in Norway. A spectacular view of the Geirangerfjord, the village of Geiranger and the cruise ships.

**Ørnesvingen Viewpoint - 620 masl**  
11 hairpin bends ascend from the Geirangerfjord to the Ørnesvingen viewpoint. View Geiranger with its near-perpendicular mountainsides, the Seven Sisters waterfall, and the mountain farms in the fjord landscape.

#### ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

##### Kayaking tours

Starting from kayak base camp in Geiranger or Hellesylt. Explore the Geirangerfjord and paddle along the fjord on a guided tour or an individual rental.

##### RIB boat tours

Enjoy an adrenaline RIB tour starting either from Hellesylt or Geiranger. See all the famous waterfalls in the fjord. Get close to the waterfalls while hearing the history of the fjord.

##### Fjord sightseeing

12 languages audio guide system. Cruise the Geirangerfjord and be overwhelmed by the stunning nature and storytelling. News from 2018 - a brand new sightseeing boat customized for the FJORD experiences.

##### Fjord cruise by boat Geiranger - Ålesund

A brand-new journey connecting the coastal town of Ålesund and Geirangerfjord. In 3 hours -3 fjord landscapes. Listen to information and history of the areas and the local people.

##### TASTE OF NORWAY

Get a chance to sample the best tastes of local food and beer. Raise a glass of Geiranger beer 'Friaren/Suitor' as you cruise past its namesake waterfall. "TASTE of NORWAY" cruise is only booked on request as a charter tour.

##### Biking tour - bike with a smile

Healthily experience the fjord landscape. Book a bike excursion, or go on your own to the valley underneath Skywalk Geiranger Dalsnibba, Flofjellet or alpine biking in Mount Stranda Panorama. You have the options of either electric bike or regular bike.

##### Hiking tour

Take a guided hike uphill and walk behind the Storseterfossen waterfall. Embrace some of the most superb and varied scenery at Mount Flofjellet, Mount Stranda Panorama or take 327 steps along the Geiranger waterfall. Alternative hike, -Nordic walking, using ski poles with storytelling from the guide.

##### Geiranger Village walk

The village with an exciting tourist history. A slow walk through the town with short stops at Geiranger Chocolate Factory, the Waterfall walk (327 steps), the Norwegian Fjord Centre and the wooden church from 1842.

##### Hellesylt village walk

A slow walk through Hellesylt village, see old houses, a stone bridge, Sunnylvn Church, Peer Gynt Art Gallery and the impressive waterfall.
